I was born in Joliet in 1991. I lived in Shorewood until the age of seven, however my home parish since birth has been St. Bernard in Homer Glen. My family moved to Homer Glen as I began the second grade. I went pre-k through 8th to SS. Cyril and Methodius in Lemont followed by four years of High School at Lockport Township High School.

After graduating high school, I entered seminary starting with four years at St. John Vianney College Seminary in St. Paul, MN. There I studied for a B.A. in philosophy and Catholic studies. Following my undergraduate years, I moved on to theological studies at Mundelein Seminary. I was ordained a priest with six other classmates at the Cathedral of St. Raymond in 2018.

I first expressed my desire to become a priest in the 2nd grade while preparing for my first communion and, more or less, have been on that same trajectory ever since. Previously I was assigned as a deacon to Holy Family, Shorewood and as parochial vicar at St. Mary Immaculate, Plainfield from 2018-2020. I am currently Parochial Vicar at SS. Peter and Paul, Naperville, my second priestly assignment.
